Gracious hosts provided both students and chaperones with great care and a wonderful itinerary during their two week trip.








• Everyone was graciously welcomed and given a tour of the city of Stuttgart the following day.



One day they took a ride down the Neckar River in a boat called a STOCHERKAHN that moves through shallow water by being pushed with a pole.












The group also spent an afternoon in Waldenbuch creating our own chocolate bars and touring the art museum at Ritter Sport!






